THE TONE

Warm, human and honest — like explaining something to a friend, not reading ad copy. No hype, no hard sell. The sentences are short because they are spoken, not read. Let them breathe.

READING NOTES

Each line is timed to what happens on screen. The duration on the left is how long that line has in the picture — treat it as a target, not a cage. The gaps between lines are real silence in the cut; you do not need to fill them.

HOW TO SAY IT

Revel	REV -uhl — as in “revelry”. Never “re-VEL”.
lets revel dot io	Written out on purpose. Say it as the address: “let’s revel dot I-O”.
R S V P	Spelled out, letter by letter: “are-ess-vee-pee”.
Q R code	Spelled out: “cue-are code”.
V A T	Spelled out: “vee-ay-tee”.
Stripe	The payment company. English, as written.
Mira, Ren, Noa, Jordan, Bea, Lena, Felix, Paul	Characters in the demos. Say them naturally.

1 Episode six. Announcements. When the venue changes

9.9 s on a Thursday night, you need to tell everyone who's
coming — once, and only the people it concerns.

— 1.3 s of silence —

2 Write it once. A title, a couple of lines, and then who it's
00:11–00:24
12.6 s for: everyone coming to this event, all your members,
one membership tier, or just the staff. Here it's the
people who said yes to Friday.

3 Send it now, or schedule it — for the morning of, or an
00:24–00:36
12.0 s hour before doors. Once it's out, the sent list tells you
exactly how many people it reached. Six, here. Nobody
who didn't need it.

— 2.9 s of silence —

4 For the people coming, it lands in their notifications —
00:39–00:52
12.8 s and in their email inbox, if they've kept that on. And it
stays on the event page, so anyone who signs up later
still finds the new room.

5 One message, the right people, and no group chat to
00:52–01:01
8.8 s scroll through. Revel is free and open source. Find it at
lets revel dot io.
