THE TONE

Warm, human and honest — like explaining something to a friend, not reading ad copy. No hype, no hard sell. The sentences are short because they are spoken, not read. Let them breathe.

READING NOTES

Each line is timed to what happens on screen. The duration on the left is how long that line has in the picture — treat it as a target, not a cage. The gaps between lines are real silence in the cut; you do not need to fill them.

HOW TO SAY IT

Revel	REV -uhl — as in “revelry”. Never “re-VEL”.
lets revel dot io	Written out on purpose. Say it as the address: “let’s revel dot I-O”.
R S V P	Spelled out, letter by letter: “are-ess-vee-pee”.
Q R code	Spelled out: “cue-are code”.
V A T	Spelled out: “vee-ay-tee”.
Stripe	The payment company. English, as written.
Mira, Ren, Noa, Jordan, Bea, Lena, Felix, Paul	Characters in the demos. Say them naturally.

1 Episode four. Invite links. An invitation-only night, first

8.8 s as the organizer who makes the link, then as the friend
who gets it.

2 For a private night, you don't publish, you invite. A
00:10–00:24
13.8 s shareable link carries the invitation: a name, how many
times it can be used, and until when. And if you say so,
it can waive a questionnaire, or a capacity limit.

3 Copy it, and send it wherever your people already are.
00:24–00:28
3.6 s

— 2.6 s of silence —

4 Mira isn't on the list. She can see the night exists, and
00:31–00:36
5.8 s that's all. The door is closed.

— 2.0 s of silence —

5 Whoever gets the link sees exactly what it grants before
00:38–00:49
10.7 s they claim it: which night, until when, and how many
uses are left. Nobody joins something by accident.

6 Claim it, and the same page opens up. Now it asks
00:49–00:56
6.7 s whether she's coming. One tap, and she's on the list.

7 Private events, invited people, one link. Revel is free and
00:56–01:04
7.8 s open source. Find it at lets revel dot io.
