THE TONE

Warm, human and honest — like explaining something to a friend, not reading ad copy. No hype, no hard sell. The sentences are short because they are spoken, not read. Let them breathe.

READING NOTES

Each line is timed to what happens on screen. The duration on the left is how long that line has in the picture — treat it as a target, not a cage. The gaps between lines are real silence in the cut; you do not need to fill them.

HOW TO SAY IT

Revel	REV -uhl — as in “revelry”. Never “re-VEL”.
lets revel dot io	Written out on purpose. Say it as the address: “let’s revel dot I-O”.
R S V P	Spelled out, letter by letter: “are-ess-vee-pee”.
Q R code	Spelled out: “cue-are code”.
V A T	Spelled out: “vee-ay-tee”.
Stripe	The payment company. English, as written.
Mira, Ren, Noa, Jordan, Bea, Lena, Felix, Paul	Characters in the demos. Say them naturally.

1 Episode seventeen. Paid memberships. A club that runs on monthly dues, first from the organizer's side, then as someone joining.

2 A membership tier can carry plans: a price, a period, and how it's paid. By card, renewing automatically through Stripe. Offline, where you record the dues you actually receive. Or free.

3 Eight euros a month, by card. Create it, and it's on the club's membership page.

5.1 s

— 3.0 s of silence —

4 For members, the page says what it costs, when it renews, and what happens if a payment ever fails. Subscribe, pay, and the membership is live.

— 3.1 s of silence —

5 It lives in your account. Next renewal, the receipts, and the buttons to change plan or cancel. Cancel, and you keep access to the end of what you've paid for.

10.2 s

— 3.6 s of silence —

6 Back at the club: who is on which plan, recurring revenue at a glance, and the cash members right next to the card ones.

00:58–01:05

7.3 s

7 Paul pays at the boathouse. Record it, and his membership rolls on for another month. No spreadsheet.

01:05–01:12

6.5 s

8 Dues, without the spreadsheet. Revel is free and open
