THE TONE

Warm, human and honest — like explaining something to a friend, not reading ad copy. No hype, no hard sell. The sentences are short because they are spoken, not read. Let them breathe.

READING NOTES

Each line is timed to what happens on screen. The duration on the left is how long that line has in the picture — treat it as a target, not a cage. The gaps between lines are real silence in the cut; you do not need to fill them.

HOW TO SAY IT

Revel	REV -uhl — as in “revelry”. Never “re-VEL”.
lets revel dot io	Written out on purpose. Say it as the address: “let’s revel dot I-O”.
R S V P	Spelled out, letter by letter: “are-ess-vee-pee”.
Q R code	Spelled out: “cue-are code”.
V A T	Spelled out: “vee-ay-tee”.
Stripe	The payment company. English, as written.
Mira, Ren, Noa, Jordan, Bea, Lena, Felix, Paul	Characters in the demos. Say them naturally.

1 Episode three. Pick your seat. A venue with real rows,
00:00–00:10
9.6 s first from the organizer's layout designer, then from the
seat map a buyer sees.

— 1.1 s of silence —

2 A venue is drawn once and reused for every show:
00:11–00:22
11.5 s sectors, rows and seats, with the price zones painted
right onto the map. A ticket tier then sells from one
sector.

— 2.7 s of silence —

3 As a buyer, the map is the ticket page. Grey seats are
00:25–00:33
8.0 s already sold, and whatever you tap is held for you for
ten minutes.

4 Pick two seats together, add the names, and reserve.
00:33–00:43
9.6 s Each seat is priced on its own, so the front rows can cost
more than the back without a separate tier.

— 2.4 s of silence —

5 In your dashboard, the ticket names the hall, the row
00:45–00:52
6.5 s and the seat. The door scanner reads the same thing.

6 Reserved seating, without a box-office contract. Revel is
00:52–01:00
8.2 s free and open source. Find it at [lets revel dot io](https://letsrevel.io).
