THE TONE

Warm, human and honest — like explaining something to a friend, not reading ad copy. No hype, no hard sell. The sentences are short because they are spoken, not read. Let them breathe.

READING NOTES

Each line is timed to what happens on screen. The duration on the left is how long that line has in the picture — treat it as a target, not a cage. The gaps between lines are real silence in the cut; you do not need to fill them.

HOW TO SAY IT

Revel	REV -uhl — as in “revelry”. Never “re-VEL”.
lets revel dot io	Written out on purpose. Say it as the address: “let’s revel dot I-O”.
R S V P	Spelled out, letter by letter: “are-ess-vee-pee”.
Q R code	Spelled out: “cue-are code”.
V A T	Spelled out: “vee-ay-tee”.
Stripe	The payment company. English, as written.
Mira, Ren, Noa, Jordan, Bea, Lena, Felix, Paul	Characters in the demos. Say them naturally.

1 Episode eight. Safer spaces. What happens when a name that shouldn't be there tries to come in. First as the organizer, then as the person whose name matched.

2 Some spaces need to keep certain people out. Under Blacklist, an entry can carry hard identifiers, an email address or a Telegram handle, and those block right away. Or soft ones: a first name, a last name, a preferred name. Those still match when the spelling is a little off, and instead of a block, they ask for a check. Add a short note on why, for whoever runs the door next year, and it's done.

3 Now Jordan opens the night. No R S V P button. Instead, an honest message that something needs checking, and a way to say: that's not me.

4 Jordan writes a line, and a verification request goes to the organizer with the message attached. Until they answer, the page says so, and nothing else changes.

5 And the organizer decides, with the context in front of them: the name, which entry it matched, and what Jordan wrote. Members of the community skip the name check entirely. They're already trusted.
